

STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

New student organizations or activities shall be formed only with the approval of the board of education. Students and/or district patrons desiring to create a new organization or activity should first present their request to the building principal. The principal will visit with those interested parties to secure detailed information. If it is determined that the prospective organization or activity is worthy of additional consideration, the proposal will be forwarded to the superintendent of schools. The superintendent of schools will see that the proposal is placed on a school board agenda for consideration by the board of education. The individuals requesting the new organization or activity will be informed of the time of the board meeting and shall be provided the opportunity to present their proposal to the board of education for its consideration.

Social activities are to be scheduled through the school principal's offices. No school activities will be held on Wednesday evening or Sunday without special permission from the superintendent of schools. At all social functions, the school house doors will be closed one-half hour after the activity has begun. After arriving students may not leave the building and return.

All groups are to be out of the buildings by 10:30 p.m. on school nights and 12:00 midnight on Friday or Saturday night except for the Homecoming Dance and the Junior-Senior Prom which may last until 1:00 a.m. or later, if approved by administration.

Students may bring outside guests under the age of 21 to social activities with the approval of the administration. The names of guests must be reported to the administrative office prior to the event.
