Athlete Participation: Each school may submit 3 athletes per event and each athlete can only participate in 4 events

Packets will be given out which include:

Pole vault certification cards, poles must be properly marked for weight.

Vaulter card must have exact weight for competitors in order to compete

Meet itinerary, Heats and Flights

Relay cards

Heats and lanes: Set after Scratch/Add meeting. Running events – all finals will be ran against time

Qualifications:

Prelims will be used for the following events: (Qualify 8 in all events)

- Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot, Discus, 100 & 110 meter hurdles, 100 & 200 meter dash
- High jump and pole vault opening heights will be determined after entries have been received

Equipment: Shot/Discus: Teams furnish their own, they must be available for all to use

Blocks are provided

Athletes must obey the 1/8" or less pyramid rule. No needle spikes

Meet Workers: The Leyton High School track team will be assisting with field events.

Locker rooms: No locker rooms will be provided

Awards/Scoring: The first six places will be scored 10-8-6-4-2-1. Medals will be given for 1st through 6th Places in all events. Packets can be picked up from the press box at the conclusion of the meet. Team champion and runner-up awards will also be presented.

Team Camps: Team camps are to be located in the designated team camp area.

Hospitality: Will be provided for coaches/bus drivers in the red bus barn.

Bus Parking: On the East and/or South side of the facility, along the street

Amenities: Concession stand and restrooms are available on the track infield

Seating: Spectators are to stay in the bleachers on the West side of the track during running events
